

# **AAMP Accomplishment Award**

## **PURPOSE**

To recognize an up-and-coming AAMP member who has made strides in the meat industry. The award will honor a person or persons who have, for example, achieved outstanding company growth, successfully developed a new product, invention or service, or launched a noteworthy marketing campaign.

## **RATIONALE**

The Accomplishment Award considers firm operators who deserve a business-oriented award for their accomplishments in a relatively short period of time (and is not to be confused with the Achievement Award which covers a long period of industry contributions). This award targets members that will serve as an example for the next generation of meat business owners. (Past Accomplishment Award winners are not eligible for consideration.)

## **CONSIDERATIONS**

- ✓ Winner must be an AAMP member and plant owner/operator.
- ✓ Nominees will demonstrate excellence, ingenuity and success in making changes in their business; achieving unusual results or financial success, or having an impact on the industry.
- ✓ A “team” can win the award: i.e. partners, brothers, husband and wife, etc.

## **NOMINATIONS**

Nominations may be made by the nominee themselves, employees, other AAMP members or another business. The nomination is submitted by completing an Accomplishment Award nomination form with as much detail as possible. Nominations not selected will be held for a period of two years. After that time, if the nominee is not selected, their nomination is discarded and they must be resubmitted for consideration.

## **SELECTION**

The AAMP Staff will review nominations. The Accomplishment Award recipient will be selected and voted on by the Board of Directors with an AAMP Staff recommendation.

## **AWARD PRESENTATION**

A write up will be done using information supplied by the nomination form and a plaque will be awarded to the recipient at the American Convention of Meat Processors.
